ALL the words you read are from real clients that have attended.

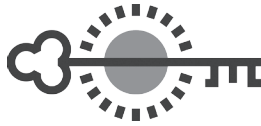

“Emotions and attitude are two basic factors that after months and years of frustration and failure, suffer immensely, especially with sensitive children. Their attitude is poor, emotionally they are sad or depressed, self-esteem is low, they have failed so many times, they don’t want to try anything new. And once they truly realize they are poor at academics, they are always totally frustrated by it. Behaviors become ingrained too as avoidance techniques, e.g. using distractions, acting silly, or if those don’t work, just shutting down and being willing to accept the most tortuous punishment rather than do one more problem of academics.

Dear Jill and everybody at Stowell:

I wanted to let you know how much I appreciate everything you've done for my children Josh and Rachel. Rachel is finishing 5th grade and doing very well. She has become an avid reader reading 100 pages or more daily. She finished all the required book reports for 5th grade in the first month of school.

I don't think it's possible for me to express how much that means to me – because when I first brought Rachel to you she was in first grade – and I was afraid she would never be able to read. Her kindergarten teacher had 4 pages of concerns. She was only able to match 4 letters of the alphabet with their corresponding sounds at the end of kindergarten. She had speech delay as a child and had been enrolled in special education at school. The music listening program did amazing things for her in a relatively short period of time. I was just reading through my yearbooks from the years and my brain flooded back with memories that I had either forgotten or were shoved away back into my head. All the activities we had. The field trips were great fun, Mrs. Fry was a terrific enthusiastic teacher, the staff was nice and were our educators and friends, the kids I was in class with I got to know really well and then me (I do wish I had kept in touch with them), I learned so much.

When I first attended here in early 2015, I was anxious. I was very nervous. I had not been in school since September of 2014. Throughout the first months, I learned PACE, rebuilt my math skills and foundations, and AST comprehension.

For math, back in middle school through early high school, I did not even try doing any of the math homework. I felt as if I could not do it and lacked motivation.

Once I came over to Stowell they proceeded to teach me the very basics of math, to build a foundation then onwards towards higher grade math. I felt much more confident in math. I had a feeling of “Wow, I can actually do this.” and my motivation for math grew.

I can really say that without Stowell, I would not be as focused, motivated, confident, and comfortable to be back in school. They have truly helped me and I cannot describe how thankful I am to have had the chance for them to help me grow in life and at school.

With AST Comprehension, it helped me slow down with reading since I was basically Speedy McGee, which did not help at all with remembering the story such as main points, the plot, why this character did this or that, etc. AST Comprehension also helped me in reading more fluently and making pictures in my head to better help me remember the story.

PACE I found fun and interesting. With PACE, it helped me to focus, think quicker, and solve problems and puzzles as quickly as possible. With each level getting more challenging and interesting, surely it benefitted me.

After the summer of 2015, my programs changed since I was going back to school, but the school was not just an ordinary one, it was a middle college. My new school assigned more homework than a regular school, so my programs at Stowell helped me more in doing my homework and organization, which is executive function and QRI. These programs started to play a beneficial role for me.

I have always had pretty bad anxiety that made it so much harder for me to focus in school and have a social life. It was very limiting for me. QRI relaxes your body as well as integrate your reflexes, which helps in learning and being

more focused in a learning environment. QRI reduced my anxiety and helped in learning. Executive function helped me visualize what homework to do and helped with my organization skills.

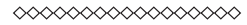

“My son began at Stowell when he was 10 years old. Although he had speech therapy as a toddler and had attended occupational therapy and used horse therapy, he still had issues in his learning. As he began first grade our insurance no longer provided therapy for the children unless they had a diagnosis of a severe disability. Every back-to-school night I would be in tears because the goals they had for the students to accomplish were going to be a struggle for my son, if he even would be able to do them at all. I was feeling very frustrated and helpless.

Because of the struggles he had he repeatedly asked me to homeschool him. We had our ups and downs in homeschooling but when we began the 5th grade curriculum he seemed to have forgotten the math skills we had gone over in 4th grade. An educator suggested I have him tested for dyslexia and that was how we discovered Stowell.

My son’s diagnosis was not dyslexia but an auditory processing disorder, with some mild eye tracking difficulties, and the sensory integration problems we already knew about. He began his therapy attending three and half hours a week.

He now only attends Stowell during the school year once a week.

He takes honor level classes and has a GPA of 3.85.

My daughter, Emily, has been attending Stowell Learning Center for almost 8 years. During that time she has never stopped showing improvement. We first came in the summer after 2nd grade.

Whatever SLC is doing it works. It has affected every aspect of school. It improved her balance and her attention. She can think now, and reason and plan. She's on the honor roll.

Emily has Cerebral Palsy with multiple physical, developmental and intellectual disabilities. Speech so bad nobody could understand her. Gross motor so bad she fell daily and knocked over things frequently. Fine motor so bad she could not form recognizable letters. She couldn't even be tested accurately, since every area has some disability.

I investigated many different speech therapists. Finally, I knew to look for a speech therapist who knew about working with brain trauma. But that was just speech. Her physical disabilities were not being helped much by physical and occupational therapy, or by adaptive PE, although they were all valuable in their own ways.

Nothing addressed the fact that she couldn't read. She had kept up in Kindergarten, but at the beginning of the 2nd semester of 1st grade, they left her behind. After a couple of tries, we found

someone who could assess her whole mind, not just speech, not just PT, not just OT. What we found was many many needs...including cognitive weaknesses, auditory and visual processing delays, decoding, comprehension, fluency, oral and written expressive processing problems, oral and written motor issues. How could we possibly spend enough time getting all the therapies to address this wide array of difficulties.

The bottom line was that the Stowell Learning Center's program for Emily would address all these areas by drawing from many different programs. We didn't have to waste time with hours and hours of work on programs that didn't fit Emily's needs. And as these needs vary as time goes on Stowell learning Center tweaks Emily's program to address them.

Whatever SLC is doing it works. It has affected every aspect of school. It improved her balance and her attention. She can think now, and reason and plan. She's on the honor roll. Emily stopped being a hazard at school and

My son Christopher has been a client at Stowell Learning Center for 3 years. We have participated in the summer intensive program, after school day program, and this year in the intensive program during the school year.

I wish I had found Stowell when we first realized he had a learning disability 10 years ago.

Christopher has become more independent and has improved in his many areas of concern including verbal skills, written skills, reading/comprehension skills, physical awareness skills, coordination and many other problem areas we have been working on over the last 10 years. Our most significant improvements have been accomplished after joining Stowell's program!

What a difference it could have made for him.

Chris' deficit is mainly in the speech/ language areas. In our neighborhood I could not find a speech therapist or occupational therapist to continue his therapy locally. School schedules became too demanding for us to continue to commute to Pasadena for services. Under coincidence three years ago while visiting a speech therapist in Chino Hills I was referred to the Stowell Learning Center. I was really impressed with all the areas they were going to cover

in the program they created for him. It was quite a comprehensive program. So I waited to see if the promises for improvement would follow. After a summer intensive program with them, I was convinced that we had found a program that he can continue to work with.

We will be entering high school and I feel confident that Chris is ready to pursue his high school education. Though he does not perform well on standardized testing and he still needs a little more time to process language assignments than his peers, I see that Christopher is capable of following instructions in class, studying his course work at home independently, and reviewing properly to do well on his tests. He is currently getting A and A—in his 4 major academic courses. Three years ago I was still sitting with him and having to sometimes “reteach” language intensive coursework at home. What a huge improvement for 3 years. I wish I had found Stowell when we first realized he had a learning disability 10 years ago. What a difference it could have made for him.

For any child who is having academic challenges I would highly recommend they give Stowell a chance to evaluate the child and help make his/her academic journey easier.

Dear Ms. Stowell:

How are you doing?

Aaron was only 3 and half years old and diagnosed in Taiwan with Autism. We were told he would be unable to go to school.

How time flies. It's almost 7 months after we came back to Taiwan from L.A. the US in last summer. I just have to thank you a million times about Aaron's progress. You were right about your prediction that Aaron would be a strong learner after he took some programs at Stowell Learning Center. To our surprise, he made a huge progress, even though he had only taken a 9 week program there. Before that, he had received language therapy for a long period of time (in the US). Sometimes, I just had to convince myself that it worked well, since that was my decision to let him have the therapy besides school's special class. At that time, I worried if that was a right way to help Aaron or not, since he had made only a little progress. Moreover, we spent a lot of our savings and we couldn't afford the wrong decision, not only for the money, but also for Aaron's critical time.

All in all, after 3 years of searching since the time Aaron was only 3 and half years old and diagnosed in Taiwan with Autism. We were told he would be unable to go to school. Thankfully we believed what you said, that Aaron was a child with an auditory processing disorder.

After the training in Stowell Learning Center last summer, some teachers here and some of my friends noticed Aaron's improvements and mentioned that to me. Two months after we left the US, Aaron told me, "Mommy, I feel that I'm smarter now." I cried at that moment. I completely knew that he didn't really become smarter, just your program happened to help his weakness and turned him into a strong learner. I just don't know how I can explain my highest appreciation about you and those teachers' profession. Thank you very much.

“My demanding school greatly limited my ability to thoroughly document the details of Joshua’s response to Phase II of Sound Therapy. As such I decided it would be appropriate to give an overview of my observations relating to Joshua’s overall progress and development.

Prior to therapy, Joshua was very quiet and reserved. His vocabulary was limited and sentences structure was fragmentary in nature. He struggled with simple tasks and became exceedingly frustrated when he was unable to communicate his needs and desires. He opted for individual play as opposed to interaction with others. This is mainly due to his limited vocabulary and his inability to adequately communicate with others his own age. Children would tease him or ignore him altogether. This isolation caused Joshua

to become depressed at times. Also, Joshua did not display fundamental characteristics of a four year old, i.e.

imaginative play, horseplay, etc. Developmentally, Joshua was also behind. His fine motor skills were limited and at times his movements seemed awkward or uncoordinated.

UNBELIEVABLE...AMAZING...
MIRACULOUS...are but a few words to describe Joshua's progress since starting on Samonas Sound Therapy. Joshua no longer sits on the sidelines while others are playing. He participates in group activities. He also enjoys "horseplay" with his dad and brothers. He's more aggressive with them now.

He is extremely imaginative. (For example: Joshua pretends to be Spiderman. He wears a hood of his head to simulate a mask. He then imitates the "shooting of the web" while making his own sound effects. Or he'll pretend to be "Larry Boy" by tucking a towel into the back of his shirt to replicate a cape.)

He is now able to follow simple instructions without constant repeating. He still requires structure and routine, but not as stringently. He is less frustrated because he is able to communicate his feelings to others. Joshua has also gained a sense of humor and a wonderful air of confidence. While I don't always appreciate his open defiance, I am

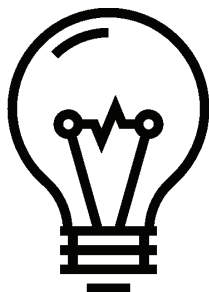

extremely pleased that he is able to tell me what he wants. And his newfound tenacity shows me that he truly has a desire to follow through on his thoughts and actions. Joshua still has difficulty performing tasks that utilize his fine motor skills, e.g. cutting, holding any type of writing utensil, etc. These are areas that we are still working on.

My name is Debra, my son's name is Caleb and we live in Glendora, CA. I am a teacher, I have a background in Special Ed.

Caleb was definitely not being serviced in school even though services were being provided for him. It was definitely evident that he needed more. and his lack of motivation. And those were the two highest on my list because as a teacher myself if you can't motivate a student with positives or with negatives it leaves you

nowhere to go. And so we found him very much not motivated by anything and it was really problematic – at school, at home and then just not connecting with other kids. He felt very lonely even though kids liked him and he was able to play with kids but his own perception of himself was that he could not relate to other kids.

We've seen the academic growth which is awesome, but those two things, that's immeasurable.

At his last IEP meeting, everyone went around the room and said Caleb's strengths and the room had completely changed since 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ years ago, since we first started at Stowell. Every single school personnel said, two of his strengths were his motivation and his social skills. And I started crying, I was like, "you don't even know, I wish I could have tape recorded the first meeting."

We've seen the academic growth which is awesome, but those two things, that's immeasurable.

My biggest concern in the beginning was that this was going to be a tutoring center. Especially because of the "learning center" title. So I was concerned that, as much as academics was important, it wasn't the top of the list. So I was worried. At that point, when you have a kid, your child is struggling, you will do anything to have him succeed. The question is, "Will it work?" And you don't know until you do it. So that was our biggest fear. We took a leap of faith and we started, and within 2 weeks we saw something I didn't even associate with his diagnosis but it was something Caleb was doing probably 8 – 20 times a day was chewing on his shirt. He would pick up his shirt, put it in his mouth and chew on it. I didn't associate it with him struggling. I just thought it was a habit. He would have to change shirts 3 times a day. We threw away shirts. Wet shirts down to the middle of his chest. Within 2 weeks of us starting he stopped. Just stopped and never started again. My husband and I looked at each other and

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thought, “OK, this is working. It’s a lot of money and a lot of time but it’s doing something.” So that was really encouraging that within 2 weeks we saw changes and then we kept seeing changes and growth. The evidence was the changes that were happening in our son.

I would say it’s worth giving it a shot. I would say that Stowell is a place where your child will be cared for, and that there really is a plan—it’s not guess work. Every child is different but I think the reason why I see the same families in the waiting room is because they’re seeing something change and that’s what we want for our kids is for them to change and grow. They aren’t accommodating like they are in school. That’s fabulous. I think, that we in special education, our kids have the opportunity to be accommodated. But here they’re changing, they’re growing and that’s exciting.”

“Hi, my name is David and my daughter has been coming to Stowell now for almost two years. Initially, she didn’t really say a whole lot. She wasn’t very verbal. She had a hard time articulating her words. We just thought that she was just young and just a kid but it wasn’t really until she was two, three years old, and and she wasn’t really developing any language skills that we realized there might be a problem. So we had her evaluated.

She was diagnosed with a speech and language disorder. So we just started having her in speech therapy and we honestly thought that that was the only problem that she had. She was very sociable. She was very friendly. She had fun interacting with her friends. She seemed very smart and capable. She had no problems handling herself around the house and doing things like that. So we just thought we could fix her speech, fix her articulation and then everything would be fine. But we went ahead and had her evaluated again.

That’s when she was diagnosed with more of a multiple learning disabilities. Not only the speech, but also Attention Deficit (ADD) and specifically an Auditory Processing Disorder where she really didn’t understand what we were saying to her when we were trying to talk to her. We just kind of took a leap of faith and brought her in

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for an evaluation here. And it's one of those things where once we got a copy of "At Wit's End", the book, and we started reading through that and we listened to things that came up in her evaluation, we were like "Oh my gosh, this is exactly my kid."

Within a month, two months, three months, she was making the kind of progress that we didn't expect she could make for years.

Stowell put forth a very good argument that we think we can permanently fix this auditory processing problem. So we went out on that leap of faith and said ok, how much would it be worth to me? I think any parent, at that age, all they want is for their child to be successful and to grow up and be independent.

And so we started her sessions and honestly, within a month, two months, three months she was making the kind of progress that we didn't expect she could make for years. Now it's been two years, but even within less than a year, all those things started to calm down. She still has Attention Deficit problems, but at the same time, she just feels so much more grounded.

There have been good days, there have been bad days. There have been good months. There have been bad months. But the progress has always been moving forward. And two years later, she's still in her Gen Ed class. She's interacting with all of her friends, all of her peers. She spends most of her time in the classroom environment, with only occasional pullouts, to be with a Special Ed teacher for certain things, but she's reading at her grade level.

The fact is that now she can do all of these things on her

own. We used to have to come home and do homework.

You know it's like, "Ok, we've got to get your homework done." She used to say, "Oh dad, I don't want to it, do we have

to?" And now, even if it's "Daddy, I'm reading. I don't want to do my homework." It's like, "Come

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on, let's do your homework." She'll say, "OK." She comes, we do her homework and she's locked into focus. Even if she's having trouble, I'll say, "You know what, maybe we should take a break." She'll say, "No. I can do this. I can get through this. I can do it." And it's that confidence that she's gotten over the last two years because of the things she's learned at Stowell. There's nothing she's doing here that's specifically academic. What I love the most about Stowell is that they're not trying to teach her how to do math or how to read. They're not trying to teach her how to get the right answer. It's all about the process. It's all about the fundamentals of how do we listen to these things? How do we break down the problem? How do we approach what's going on? It's not tutoring. It's learning how to think and how to get around her impediments. And from that foundation she's able to then go out and read on her own because she has the tools.

If it wasn't for Stowell, she would not be anywhere near where she is today. And if you had told me, two years ago when she was in first grade, that she would reach this level of accomplishment now I would have said I don't care how much it costs. I'll give you a million bucks! Please help her! And that's really what it came down to. And so we took that leap of faith and we've seen that level of success. Honestly, I couldn't be happier. So, thank you."
